THE MINERS DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE

MMAC shall be the voice of the mining districts providing guidance and balance to the important strategic mineral, metal and rare earth homeland needs and mining interests as they are intended to coexist with the Bureau of Land Management (BLM). In accomplishing this mission, MMAC will tear off the bonds of over regulations, duplicated regulations, confusion, agency and group interference, cutting down on paperwork, cutting down on law suits, debunking flawed analysis and information, cutting state and federal spending on behalf of minerals and mining, clarification who is in charge and a working coexistence relationship with BLM. In completion of this mutual coexistence, MMAC will be creating thousands of brand new long-term, high-paying jobs, ie: mining, parts, vendors, manufacturing, rentals, wholesalers and retailers. MMAC and BLM can work together managing the public lands for minerals and mining and shall be the only 2 recognized public lands management agencies for minerals and mining. Yes this means MMAC would become a Federal Agency either by Congress or by the 1872 Mining Laws. Another goal of MMAC is to organize against the States trying to take back public lands for their respective state. This would give the States the chance to abolish the 1872 Mining Law. This would not be a bad thing if whoever wrote the Bill would keep in the 1872 Mining Law as intended by our forefathers. So right now we just say NO.

Another group benefiting from this is recreation. (Off-Roading, Hunting, Fishing, Hiking, Mountain Biking and just enjoying Mother Nature). Mining is guaranteed under the Multi Surface Use Act 30USC612B and the Minerals and Mining Act 30USC21a-54 to be able to access mining claims and adjacent properties. Recreation can use these roads to get to fishing spots, hunting spots, off-roading areas, hiking and mountain biking areas or just getting somewhere to see and smell the flowers, trees and air.

If Recreation, Off-Roading, Hunting, Ranching, Cattlemen and outdoor enthusiast all get together, we can take back our Public Lands, Stop Future Land Designations, correct the unprecedented spending of our government, states and counties and create thousands of brand new long-term, high paying jobs.
